

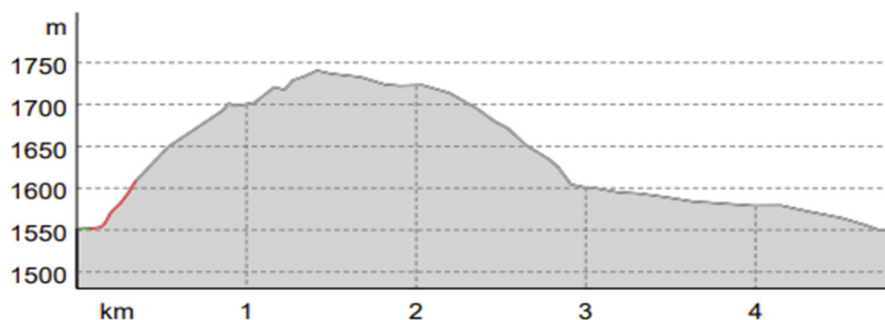
Towards the full moon

Golden views at night

Level of difficulty:	Easy snowshoe tour through gentle terrain, with a relatively short walking time.
Equipment:	Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks; ski helmet (recommended), sledges (can be hired for a fee)
Costs:	€ 20; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their parents. Free with the "Gästecard" or Nationalpark WinterCard!
Included in price:	Snowshoe and ski stick hire (please advise when booking)
Meeting point:	Thursday, 25.01.2024 at 16:30; Saturday, 24.02.2024 at 16:30; Monday, 25.03.2024 at 17:00; at the Bodenhaus car park, Kolmstraße 6, 5661 Rauris
How to reach us:	By the "Tälerbus" or by car to the Bodenhaus car park
Duration:	Approx. 4 hours
Pure walking time:	Approx. 2.5 hours
Route:	Approx. 5–5.5 kilometres
Ascent:	Approx. 200 vertical metres
Refreshment stops:	Various options available, including: Ammererhof;
Booking:	Until 11:00 on the day of the tour; or for the Saturday tour booking is necessary by Friday 11:00

Description: Before the walk begins, a taxi service will take the group to the Lenzanger car park. From there you will start the walk with the national park ranger – the moon will soon be shining brightly. After a short walk through the forest, you will find yourself in a quiet glade where you can enjoy watching the full moon. The trail then slowly descends along a path towards winter pastures and an inn. This is where the winter snowshoe hike ends – you can choose to follow the ranger back to the car park or spend the evening in the cosy atmosphere of the inn.
