

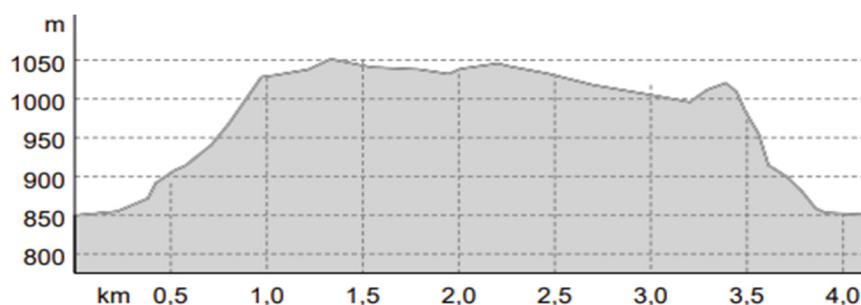
## Primordial Sulzbach valleys

Where nature has preserved its diversity

- Level of difficulty:** Moderately difficult snowshoe hike that requires a very good level of fitness and takes you through steep terrain
- Equipment:** Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), sunscreen, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks
- Costs:** € 20; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their parents.  
Free with the "Gästecard" or Nationalpark WinterCard!
- Included in price:** Snowshoe and ski stick hire (please advise when booking)
- Meeting point:** Every Thursday (from 28.12.23–28.03.24) at 10:00 from the Schütthof inn
- How to reach us:** By bus (route 670 to "Neukirchen Dürnbach" bus stop, then approx. 15–20 minutes on foot) or car to the Schütthof inn
- Duration:** Approx. 4.5–5 hours
- Pure walking time:** Approx. 2.5 hours
- Route:** Approx. 4–4.5 kilometres
- Ascent:** Approx. 200 vertical metres
- Refreshment stops:** Possible at the end of the tour
- Booking:** No booking required – Simply turn up at meeting point at the specified time, our ranger will start punctually

**Description:** The snowshoe hike starts at the Schütthof Inn. After a few hundred metres across meadows, you quickly reach the entrance to the forest. Past the Untersulzbach Falls natural monument, you may be lucky enough to spot animal tracks. Clearings provide frequent views down into the valley. After about 2km you reach the end of the stage, the Hochfeld mining museum, which is open for guided tours in the summer. The return route is on the other side of the Untersulzbach. A varied winter experience is guaranteed!
