

Keeskogel – the highest ski tour in the Grossarl valley

Level of difficulty: "Alpine tours that require good physical fitness, more than 5 hrs total time and/or steeper terrain; led by a state-certified mountain guide."

Equipment: Ski touring equipment (skis, sticks, skins, crampons, helmet), winter clothing, change of clothes, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks, sun and cold protection;

Costs: € 40 per person

Participants: min. 3 people, max. 6 people

Hire: Avalanche equipment (please advise when booking)

Meeting point: Monday, 25.03.2024, at the Talschluss Talwirt car park in Hüttschlag; time will be advised when you book.

How to reach us: By bus (route 540 – "Hüttschlag Talschluss" stop) or car to the Talwirt car park

Duration: Approx. 10 hrs

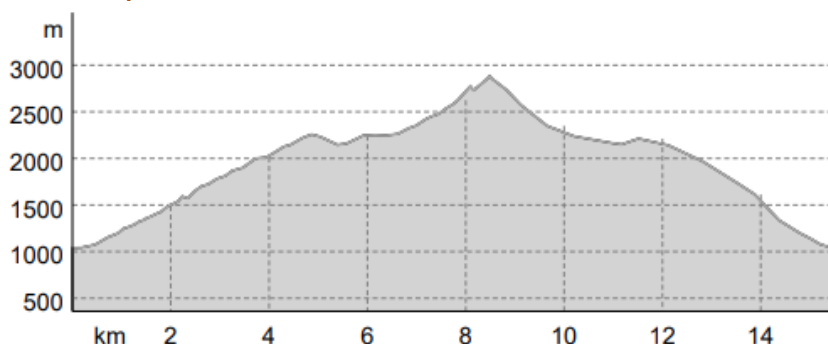
Ascent: Approx. 1900 vertical metres and 9 kilometres

Descent: Approx. 1900 vertical metres and 9 kilometres

Description: A long ski tour for experienced skiers offering the chance to explore the once glaciated Keeskogel cirque. From the summit, you'll be rewarded with panoramic views of the Ankogel and Hochalm peaks within the Carinthian National Park, as well as the neighbouring Kötschach valley. The specific route will be determined by snow, avalanche and weather conditions.
