

Crossing the Pölsneralm to the "Platte" (snowshoe tour)

Level of difficulty: "Alpine tours that require good physical fitness, more than 5 hrs total time and/or steeper terrain; led by a state-certified mountain guide."

Equipment: Sturdy hiking boots, warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (incl. hat and gloves), sun protection, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks

Costs: € 30 per person

Participants: min. 3 people, max. 8 people

Included in price: Snowshoe and ski stick hire (please advise when booking)

Meeting point: Friday, 09.02.2024;
Friday, 01.03.2024;
at 09:00 at the Hollersbachtal car park

How to reach us: By bus to Hollersbach, then approx 10 minute walk (route 670, "Hollersbach im Pinzgau Ortsmitte" bus stop) or car to the Hollersbachtal car park

Duration: Approx. 6 hours

Route: Approx. 8 kilometres

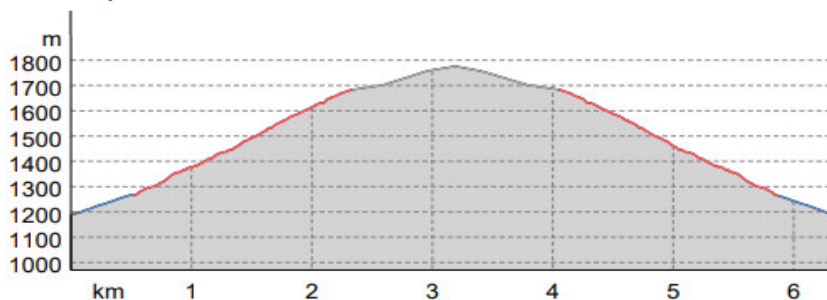
Ascent: Approx. 650 vertical metres

Description: The trail leads through a snow-covered spruce forest via the Pölsneralm to the "Platte". This is a rewarding panoramic peak with unobstructed views of the entire Salzach valley and surrounding mountains. The specific route will be determined by snow, avalanche and weather conditions.

Note: Guests are transferred to the national park minibus at the Hollersbachtal car park. This prevents congestion on the way to Berghof.
